At the recent World Medical Association Council meeting in Livingston there was a real commitment to setting up collaborative groups—and to sharing experience between countries. Pathway effects are experiences that set individuals onto trajectories that influence health, well-being, and competence over the life course.

It is clear that there is widespread support for a SDH approach across the world. The European Parliament has recently allocated funds to develop pilot projects designed to test the feasibility and usefulness of action in the area of health inequalities. For example, in South Australia, HiAP approach has been adopted in response to escalating healthcare costs driven by an ageing population and increasing incidence of chronic disease.
