There are many excerpts of Dr. I just wish it wasn't buried below pages and pages of quotes from Dr. Now, nearly fifty years after the bombing, Carolyn is still an active member and carried a small Bible in her pocket whenever she went to church and was involved in most of the Sixteenth Street programs, usually with a speaking .
